# Bags Game Rules:

## Bags History:

- Target Sports are as old as time. In 1948 a wooden Bags game was created, but it was too heavy, bulky, and inconsistent.
- The Official Baggo game was developed over a five year period and the results are stronger, standardized, portable and much more competitive game.

## Equipment:

- Bags is designed for indoor or outdoor use.
- Our Bag Boards are customized and only customized bean bags should be used on boards.
- Our Bag Boards are not capable of handling any severe weather- **rain will ruin bean bags!**
- Boards are built with blow-molded, lightweight, high impact polyethylene for durability.
- Bags are a blend of heavy duty poplin (65% polyester/35% cotton and filled with treated unpopped popcorn).

## Official Rules:

- 2 or 4 players (singles or doubles).
- Distance is measured between "Foot Foul Edges".
- Ages 2 to 4- 8 feet, ages 5 to 8- 12 feet, ages 9 to 12- 15 feet, ages 13 and up (social play)- 18 feet, and tournament play- 20 feet.
- In doubles, team partners face each other from opposite boards.
- Each team plays with 4 bags, alternating tosses until all 8 bags are thrown.
- The round is then scored (see scoring section).
- The last team to score in a previous round tosses first.
- Bag etiquette necessitates respect for your opponent. Re-toss any throw interfered, respect foot foul calls, respect lines of toss, and only one person should retrieve bags after each round.

## Scoring:

- Winner is the first team to score 21 points or more.
- 3 points for each bag in the hole (that's a Baggo!), 1 point for each bag on the board (an ace).
- The score is the difference in the team totals.
- Bags pushed in by an opponent's toss count as a Baggo.
- The game is over if the score reaches 11-0 (that's a skunk).
- If a bag ever touches the ground it does not count.
- Easy scoring tip: First take away or remove offsetting bags from the board and offsetting bags in the hole. The net bag(s) are scored by counting remaining bags (score on built in scorer).

## The Lingo:

- Ace- A bag tossed onto the board (1 point).
- Baggo- A bag in the hole (3 points).
- Blocker- An Ace positioned in front of the hole to prevent sliders.
- Hanger- An Ace on the lip of the hole ready to drop.
- Honors- The team that scored last tosses first, or has "honors".
- Skunk- An 11-0 game or "Zip" game
- Slam- Player makes 4 Baggos in one round.
- Slider- A Baggo that slides into the hole.
- Swish- A Baggo that goes straight into the hole.
